







BILATERAL COOPERATION BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF CANADA AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOR AND SOCIAL WELFARE OF MEXICO

Ottawa, Canada

November 7 – 9, 2018

DESCRIPTION:

A delegation of two officers from the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare of Mexico (STPS) will travel to Canada to receive technical assistance and share knowledge and experiences on Occupational Safety & Health, specifically in the area of workers' emotional and psycho-social well-being. The discussion will focus on the analysis of the Canadian "National Intervention Model", with a view to achieve continuous improvements and consolidate Mexico's National Program for Emotional Well-being and Human Development at Work (PRONABET), established in 2015.

This Cooperation Activity will take place within the framework of the Inter-American Network for Labor Administration (RIAL), coordinated by the OAS, to support the institutional strengthening of Ministries of Labor of the region through cooperation and technical assistance. www.rialnet.org

OBJECTIVES:

General: To learn first-hand about the design, characteristics, implementation, reach, results and evaluation of Canada´s "National Intervention Model", as well as its impact within companies (enterprise-level) and at the national level.

Specific:

- Make visible the correspondence between the needs of the population served and the proposed intervention model.
- Identify strategies to increase employers' commitment.
- Learn about the tools for identifying and measuring both risks and areas of improvement within companies.
- Learn about the monitoring system for companies that participate in the "National Intervention Model."
- Learn from success stories of the companies that have participated in the program.
- Understand the differences in the promotion, implementation and impact of the program among different productive sectors.
