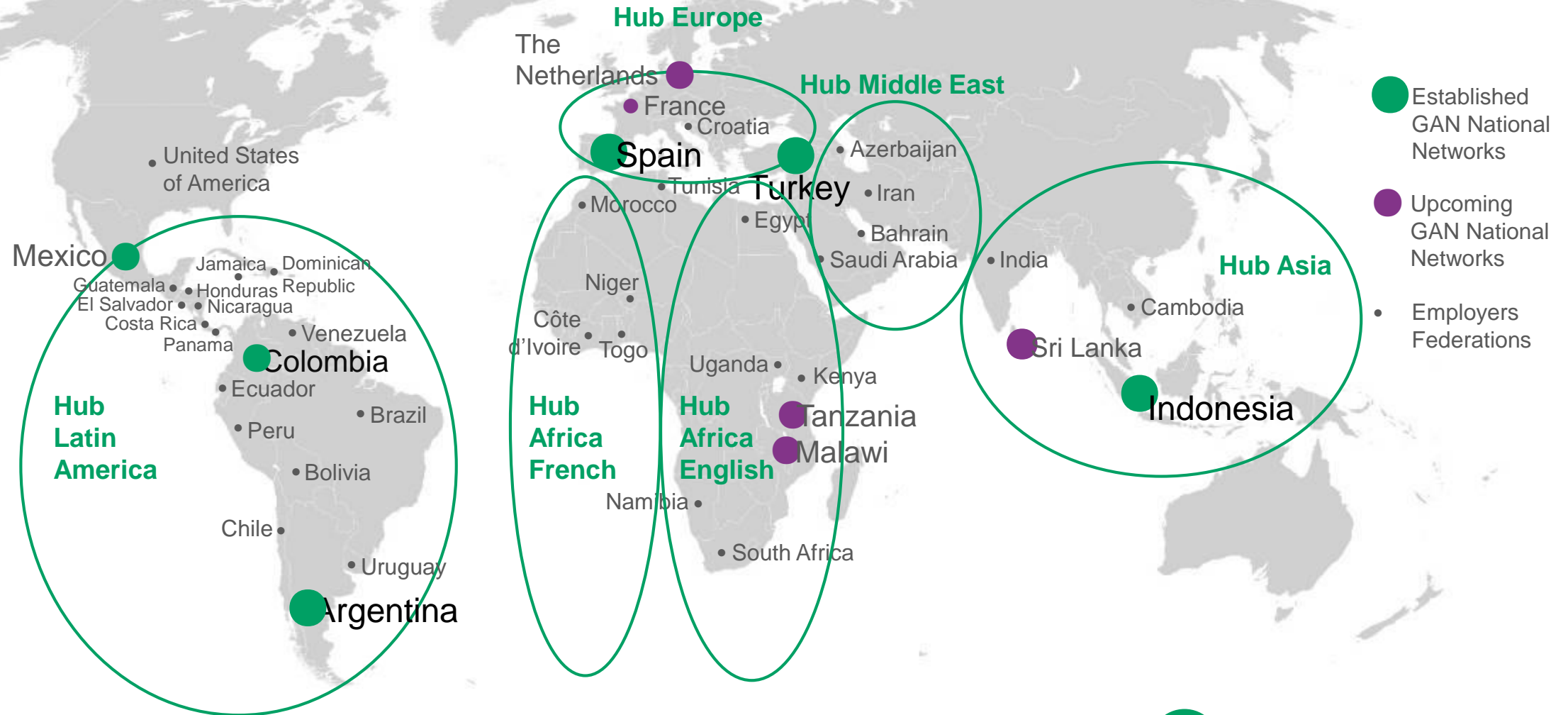


The Three GAN Principles

- I. Strengthen the **commitment and visibility** of the companies' and organizations' workforce engaged in apprenticeship and internships as part of a sound **human resources development strategy**.
- II. **Share best practices** in the areas of apprenticeships, internships, mentoring and on-the-job-training.
- III. **Encourage** a network of committed companies and organizations at global and local levels, to support **effective knowledge sharing** action programs and partnerships and to scale up **international cooperation** to this effect.
