Characteristics

- The Employment and Local Labor Observatory is a social and labor information system developed to assist national and municipal governments on the implementation of social and labor policies at local level and to assist employment offices.

Observatory management

- Assistance from the Ministry of Labor, Employment and Social Security of Argentina:
 - Development of the Employment and Local Labor Observatory.
 - Technical and financial assistance for municipalities to implement the Observatory.
 - Labor indicators produced by the Ministry are provided periodically.

Observatory management

- At municipal level :
 - Physical space and human resources available to manage the observatory.
 - Articulation with provincial and municipal officials.
 - Adaptation of the observatory model to local needs.



National network of observatories

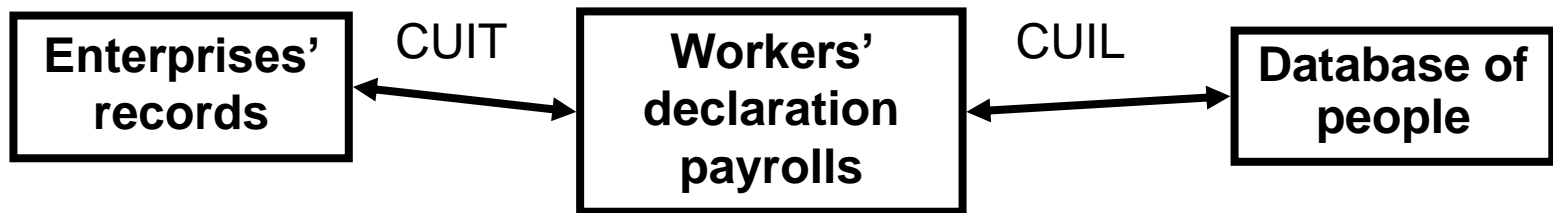
- Standardizing the information produced by Observatories will allow to access key indicators of local labor markets dynamics and their main issues. This will also facilitate regional comparative analysis.

Sources of information

- Various sources of information will be used:
 - Records made by the employment office regarding job supply and demand.
 - Other administrative records: social security records, records of the beneficiaries of employment plans, etc.
 - Development of household surveys at local level.
 - Development of enterprises surveys at local level.

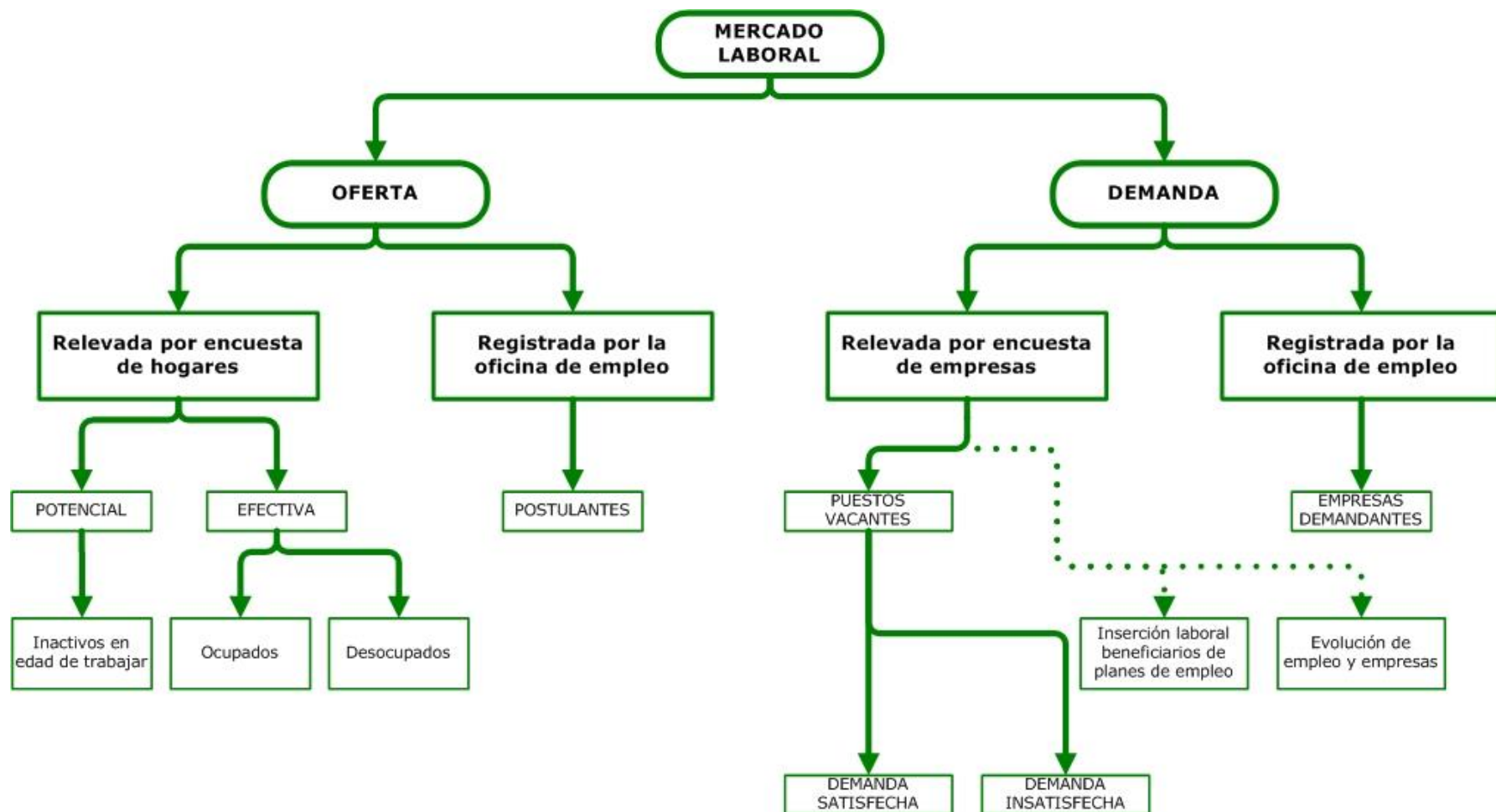
Local economic areas

- The databases available in Argentina allow to make connections between enterprises and workers within a geographic region, in order to define areas according to local labor markets or Local Economic Areas (AEL).



- The territory is defined by the addresses of workers and enterprises in which they work, based in the concept “daily movement behavior”.

- Diagnosis on the local labor situation.
- Quantification and classification of the population with problems related to employment.
- Identifying unattended labor supply and demand and their main characteristics.
